

Privacy Statement - Petition to Stop the Use of EU Agricultural Subsidies for Bullfighting

CAS International, hereafter referred to as "the initiator," respects the privacy of the signatories of this petition and ensures that the personal data you share with us is handled confidentially.

What data do we collect?

To sign this petition, we request the following information:

- Name (first and last name)
- Address and city of residence
- Email
- **Optional telephone number** (by providing your phone number, you allow CAS International to contact you once by phone to become a donor).

Why do we collect this data?

We collect this data to demonstrate support for the petition and to present it to the European Parliament. This information is necessary to ensure the credibility of the petition. If you provide a phone number, it will not be shared with the European Parliament; however, CAS International may contact you once by phone within one year of signing to ask you to become a donor.

Sharing of personal data with third parties

The collected names, cities of residence, and email addresses will be shared exclusively with the department of the European Parliament that handles this petition, in the form of a list of signatures.

Security and retention period

We take appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against loss and unlawful processing. The data will be stored until the petition has been submitted and its handling has been completed. After that, all personal data will be deleted or anonymized within 12 months.

Your rights

You have the right to:

- Request access to the data we have about you.
- Have your data corrected or deleted.
- Withdraw your consent.
